A word from the Rabbi

"If God is your co-pilot, do you still need a navigator?"

It's always easier to classify things in either/or categories: black or white, good or bad, Conservative or Liberal, milk or meat, Jew or Gentile. One category that is often used is religious or secular. "I gotta be honest, Rabbi, I'm not religious," folks will tell me (while standing in shul). "Well, you know her. She's pretty religious." Religious or not tends to be described as an either/or, rather than a both/and phenomenon.

If you know me by now, you can figure out that I find the choice between religious and secular often to be a false choice. What's more, the Torah supports this. While the Torah does not speak of a concept of "secular"—such a worldview was unheard of back then—it does contain actions we would classify as secular or religious, and offers both a secular explanation and a religious explanation. Jacob's prosperity is credited to both his sharp business mind (secular explanation), and to God's revelations to him (religious explanation). His son Joseph is made a slave in Egypt because his brothers sold him (secular reasoning), but Joseph says it is because of a Divine plan (religious reasoning). For that matter, the Torah blames the Israelites' enslavement to both Pharaoh's oppressive decisions, and to God's promise to Abraham.

A striking example of this comes from Numbers, 10:35. We're told about how the Israelites would travel: the Ark, containing the Ten Commandments, would guide them – the supernatural explanation. We even sing this section of the Torah whenever we open the ark in our synagogue: Va-yehi bin-so' ha-aron, va-yomer Moshe... It's a religious explanation if ever there was one: Who was their guide? God. (Note that they seem to be making good time until they sin and God decides to punish them with a long journey. It's not that God didn't know the way and was afraid to ask directions, as the old jokes have it.) But look what the Israelites do in the very same parsha: try to hire a guide. Moses asks his father-in-law, a local, to "please do not leave us, because you know where to camp in the wilderness and you can be our guide." (Num. 10:31). The Israelites have Divine guidance. Why do they need a human guide? Seems strangely secular.

But it isn't strange when we understand that the Torah doesn't see the same religious-secular dichotomy we often do. Jewish tradition gives both a religious response and secular response to the same situation, and we don't choose either/or, but both/and. Did the Israelites need a guide, or was God sufficient? Both. Did Jacob become wealthy because of his own cunning or because God told him what to do? Both. Are our lives influenced by God, or are there rational explanations for most everything? Both. We are not to rely on God exclusively to get us through life, nor are we to think that reason offers full explanations for all that is under the sun. Both/and, faith and reason, religion and secularism, causality and wonder.

We too often choose either/or when we do not have to. When we open the ark, we pray that the Torah will guide us as it did the Israelites, supernaturally showing us the way. But then we read it ourselves and talk about its meaning, showing that we expect to develop our minds so we can guide ourselves, just in case the miracle doesn't come through. The Lord is my shepherd, the Psalmist says, and we should aspire to that. Moses, the former shepherd, could have said the same. But he tried to hire a guide, just to be sure. We act out the both/and in shul each week, and we practice it outside our walls as well.

In that connection, I look forward to seeing you in (and out!) of shul this summer.
