a word from **THE RABBI**

I thought the pressure to get things right was high when we renovated our home. But that was before we started rebuilding our shul. A medieval Kabbalistic work, the Raya Mehemna (included in the Zohar) is quoted as saying that "A synagogue should be finely built and comfortably furnished. The synagogue below represents the synagogue on High." Decorating to get the right feel in your home is one thing, but decorating to match the Deity's tastes? Now that's pressure.

I don't know what "the synagogue on High" looks like, and, if I understand the situation correctly, I'm in no hurry to find out. I'll stay in terrestrial shuls and avoid the Heavenly ones as long as I can. That said, the Kabbalists were onto a deep spiritual insight (no surprise): God builds no space in this world (except for the world itself); the task of helping each other identify and represent the Divine in everyday life is delegated to us. We do this naturally, reflecting the Torah's view that we are all created in the Divine Image, and we do so more specifically when we create sacred spaces in which we affirm the centrality of God and the Jewish tradition in our lives. Having a welcoming space where Jews can gather and feel positively connected to the Jewish Tradition, to each other, and to themselves has always been at the forefront of this renovation project. The Zohar reminds us that it is also about feeling connected to God.

We are now on the verge of completing, (b'ezrat Hashem!) our rebuilding project and re-dedicating our shul. It is an appropriate time to look back, at the good and bad times that the Beth Jacob community has seen, and to assess the need for continuing to create a vibrant Jewish center for generations to come. Each generation does it differently: from the wooden shteibls of Europe, to the ornate prayer spaces of the Middle East, to the formal North American houses of worship of the mid-20th century, synagogues have taken all the different shapes and sizes under Heaven. So if they're all different, how can they all resemble the synagogue on High?

It's because each generation strives to understand God as well as they can, and it might be different than what came before. Our space reflects the unity of the Jewish people around the world, through the incredible Jerusalem stone. Its accessibility reflects the value we place on every human being. Its warm spaces reflect the impulse we have to shmooze and connect with each other. Its soaring spaces and classic design reflect our recognition that we are part of something greater than ourselves. Oneness, relationships, and an unending sense of mission. Attributes the Jewish tradition ascribes to God are to be reflected in our lives, and in our sacred spaces. I pray (and I believe) that, to the best of our abilities, we've done that.

Making a shul resemble God's shul is a lofty goal, and one that, even if we had a bigger budget, we'd fall short. But every generation makes its best attempt, we should be proud that we've made ours. Please join us as we re-dedicate ourselves to the central goals of the Jewish people in our new sanctuary. Please join us as we work to ensure that as our synagogue here on Earth resembles the synagogue on High, so too our actions here on Earth reflect the attributes of the Holy One on High.

The Jewish Hamilton Project
An oral history of Jewish Hamilton

Wendy Schneider and Billy Shaffir, co-creators of the Jewish Hamilton Project, will show excerpts from their oral history of Jewish Hamilton.

Through the recollections, reminiscences and reflections of Jewish Hamiltonians, including many Beth Jacobites, we come to appreciate the vibrancy of the Hamilton Jewish Community in the early years of the 20th century and through the 1960's.

Co-creators, producers and directors of this project, are Billy Shaffir, professor of Sociology at McMaster University and Wendy Schneider, editor of the Hamilton Jewish News, past-president of Beth Jacob Synagogue. Billy Shaffir came to Hamilton in the early 1970's from Montreal.

A frequent visitor to his adopted home's Jewish community centre, he heard many stories from the 'old timers' about what a wonderful place Hamilton had been in which to grow up. Wendy Schneider, born and raised in Hamilton and a scion of the well known Goldblatt family, knows Hamilton from the inside. Together they make the perfect team to bring us the Hamilton Jewish Project.

Dr. Eileen Schuller
on Sunday, January 16, 2011

The People of the Dead Sea Scrolls
and the infancy of Jewish Prayer

Who wrote the Dead Sea Scrolls, and why were these people doing what they were doing? Dr. Eileen Schuller will share the fruits of her latest studies covering Dead Sea Scroll material on prayer that has only recently come to light. Some of the earliest examples we have of berakot and fixed daily prayers come from the Dead Sea Scrolls. This has fascinating implications for views on Jewish prayer today.

Dr. Eileen Schuller has taught in the Department of Religious Studies at McMaster University in Hamilton, since 1990. She did her studies at University of Alberta, University of Toronto and Harvard University. She has been involved in the publication of the Dead Sea Scrolls since 1982 and has published the first editions of a number of manuscripts of prayer and psalm texts. Recently (2009) she prepared a re-edition of the large scroll of Thanksgiving Psalms from Cave 1. She has also written extensively on texts in the Dead Sea Scrolls that speak about women.
